NZBA's main role has been to develop, implement and administer the WHO/UNICEF Baby Friendly Initiative e.g. Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative (BFHI) and the Baby Friendly Community Initiative (BFCI) in New Zealand.

These initiatives (BFHI, BFCI) provide guidelines for practice of health providers who care for mothers (i.e. antenatal, birthing, postnatal and mothers with young children). The BFI tool provides standards of care for infant and young child feeding which are current evidenced- based guidelines, and enable assessment of practice.
